The Government of the United Republic of Tanzania through Ministry of Energy has received funds from International Development Agency (IDA) for the operation of the Energy Sector Capacity Building Project (ESCBP) during the financial year 2018/2019. It is intended that part of the fund will be used to cover eligible payment under the contract for ***Provision of Consultancy Services for Preparation of Specific Energy Sector Investment Guideline in Tanzania.***
2. The assignment is aiming at developing a specific energy sector investment guideline that will ensure implementation of economic and financial of energy sector projects is mainstreamed among the stakeholders. The guideline will help government officials who prepare energy sector development projects to advise investors a proper way of investment in the country.
